Midnite Motel is an energetic and authentic band that blends the essence of classic hard rock with a fresh, modern sound.

With thunderous riffs and sharp melodies, the quartet has crafted a powerful and unique sound, merging influences from 60s and 70s classic rock with more contemporary styles. A sound that leaves no one indifferent, turning their shows into a cathartic experience—an invitation to let go of everything and surrender to the music.

Formed in mid-2021 in Terrassa (Barcelona), Midnite Motel is a band composed of seasoned musicians.

The four members—**Carlos Ferrer** (vocals), **Ladri H** (guitar), **Sergi Gaitan** (drums), and **Jaume Roig** (bass)—have made their mark on the music scene in bands such as **Rodeo Rose**, **Sweet Emotion**, and **Casino Montreux**.



Despite their short trajectory, the band has left a significant imprint on the scene through their live performances, presenting their album across Spain and sharing the stage with bands like **The Grassland Sinners**, **SinCity**, **EVO**, **Hard Buds**, and **Leize**, as well as renowned international bands such as Germany's **Sweet Electric** and Australia's **The Casanovas** during their 2022 tour in Spain.

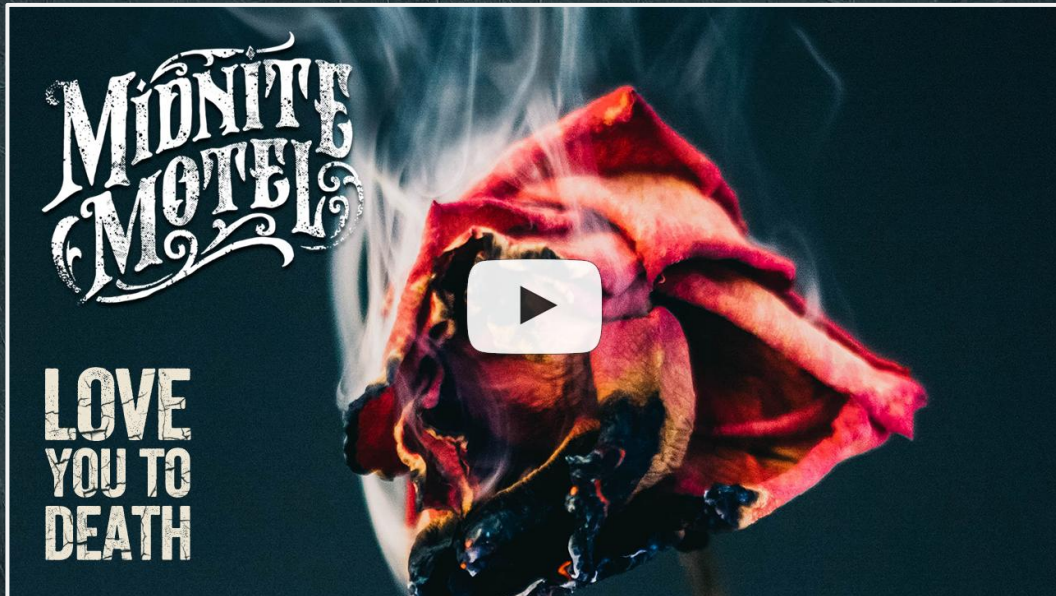
The striking and intriguing album cover and design were created by renowned Valencian artist **Manel LaVey - Leviathan**.

Midnite Motel releases "Gimme Some...", their stunning debut album.

Midnite Motel had been hinting at something big, and they've confirmed it with the release of *Gimme Some*, a stunning debut album.

Any record that kicks off with *I Don't Mind* wins you over from the very first second. The sound feels as if the band is playing right in front of you, featuring a killer 70s-style Aerosmith riff and a strikingly fitting voice. Simply outstanding.

We already talked about the sheer effectiveness of *Easy Money* a few days ago. Additionally, *Love You to Death* remains the perfect track to showcase a band that's here to take it all.

Wasted Time throws you headfirst into a riff that sounds like it was crafted by none other than Malcolm Young himself. It seeps into your veins, entangles you, and commands both your feet and head to move. Such elegance, class, and a masterful execution of classic rock.

Corner of My Eye kicks off with a Hendrix-inspired trip, transitions into a Guns N' Roses-style melody, and evolves into a top-tier American rock mid-tempo. The nods to their influences are plenty, yet they always carve their own path and forge their unique style. A brief moment of respite before what's to come.

Drive Me Up the Wall hits you hard with a riff reminiscent of Ted Nugent, full of raw power and, most importantly, a

straight shot to your brain. The 70s Kiss-style backing vocals elevate this track into an anthem you won't stop listening to.

Someday, Somewhere delivers another powerful riff, a solid keyboard foundation, and a Deep Purple-meets-Coverdale atmosphere—ingredients more than enough to create a flawless song. The band gives 100% in every beat, winning you over with their sincerity.

Far Away returns to an upbeat rock groove with a straightforward riff. AC/DC immediately comes to mind, though there are also hints of other bands you'll uncover as you listen.

The album closes with *Black Haired Lady (With a Big White Dog)*, a story-driven track featuring an intro, a playful riff, and a spectacular development—an epic finale.

Bottom line: If you love 70s rock bands and thought rock had no future in Spain, prepare to have your mind blown. They are destined for greatness, and the best part? They have the wildcard of international appeal.

Ladies and gentlemen, presenting the most powerful band on the planet: **Midnite Motel!** (And no, they didn't pay us to say this.)

Hailing from Barcelona, Spain, we find energetic hard rock quartet MIDNITE MOTEL. They have a new excellent new nine track album out now called 'Gimme Some...' which clocks in at around thirty-five minutes long and is the band's debut full length release.

The album opens up with the catchy and energy driven 'I Don't Mind'. During this track, singer Carlos Ferrer, comes across with that gravelly throaty voice like he been swallowing razor blades, and guitarist Ladri H belts out some fine vintage electric riffage throughout the song. It a catchy hard-hitting opener reminding me a little of Skid Row and Roxy Blue.

'Easy Money' is even better, this song is a harder edged sword, catchy and anthemic with fiery guitar work, with the bass and drum adding that heavy groove to the song. Carlos again hits some fine vocal notes, there is a pinch of 'You Could Of Mine' from Guns n' Roses on this anthemic ditty.

'Love You To Death' is pure melodic hard rocker, crispy fiery drilling guitars, raspy vocals with a huge 'na na na' catchy chorus, my favourite song on the album, tons of energy and swagger here.

The goodies keep coming with the heavier 'Wasted Time', this song is even more energetic, thundering drum stomping from Sergi Gaitan with fabulous shred work from Ladri, this track is pure eighties hard rock and would have been all over MTV back in the day, superb.

'Corner Of My Eye' is another outstanding song, this track is more southern blues inspired and is beautifully performed, the Hammond synths give it a sense of atmosphere and the song reminds me a lot of Bang Tango at their purist, this is just stunning and possibly the album highlight.

The chunky riffs and energy crack open 'Drive Me Up The Wall', this is a chugging classic hard rocker, again Carlos sounds great, a very infectious song, here he sounds a

little like Blackie Lawless from W.A.S.P. and the musical work has a Zeppelin vibe, making this is a cool vintage retro rocker.

'Someday, Somewhere' again goes for the vintage hard rock style, a bit of Deep Purple coming through here with the Hammond synths, the whole song is punchy vibrant and full of energy, the band sound great here.

Next up is 'Far Away', and this track is good time fun hard rock.

The album ends with the catchy 'Black Haired Lady (With A Big White Dog)' a fine groove based heavy hard rocker that will get under your skin.

'Gimme Some...' as a whole is an album that gets under your skin, its diverse, vibrant, with a solid production sound, this firecracker is exactly what we love about seventies and eighties hard rock albums, enjoy. Recommended.
